- Engaged in athletic programming and/or other extra-curricular/community activities.

Individuals providing the student nominations should complete the certification form to verify the accuracy of the nomination form and relationship to the student. The certification form can be signed by any school administrator who can verify the required information. On the nomination page, please feel free to include any additional comments about why the student should be chosen for this scholarship.

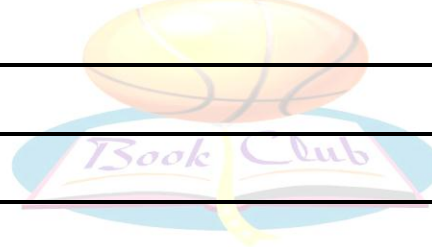

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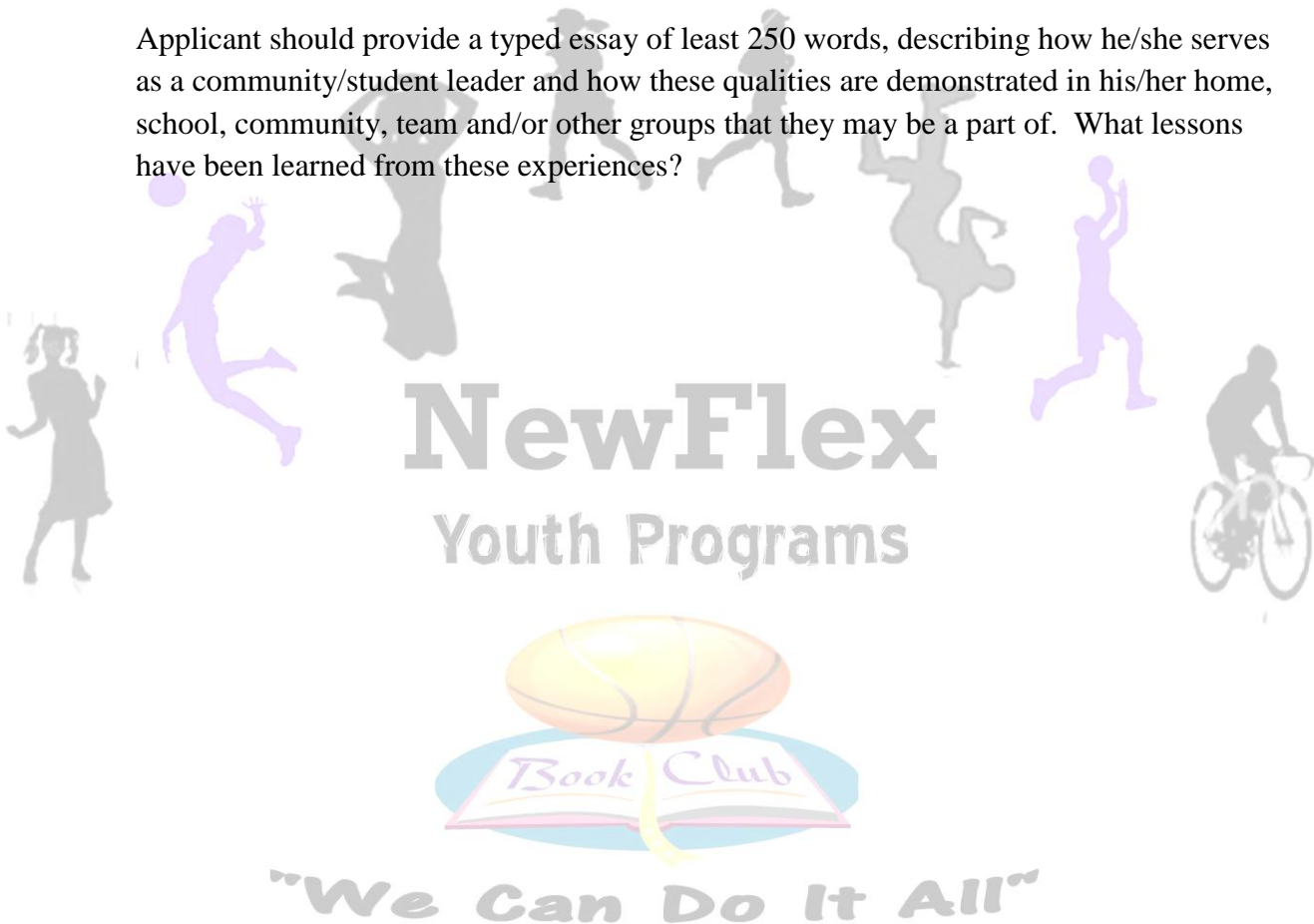


IV. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION
